



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF COLEHILL ROAD, LYTCHETT MATRAVERS

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along part of COLEHILL ROAD, LYTCHETT MATRAVERS between the Water Tower and Goat House Farm, a distance of approximately 185 metres. The Notice is needed to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on Monday 11 June 2018 and will remain in force for 5 days. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed by Wednesday 13 June 2018. The works (and the closure) will take place between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs daily.

This Notice will enable Knighton Countryside Management Ltd safe access to carry out hedge maintenance works from the highway.

The following map shows the extent of the closure (in red) and the diversion route (in blue).
