



**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER (TEMPORARY 30mph SPEED LIMIT), A350 and A35, UPTON BY-PASS**

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL and BOROUGH OF POOLE have made a Temporary Traffic Management Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. The order will come into operation on Monday 16 January 2017 and will remain in force for 18 months. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed by Friday 05 May 2017.

The order is to create a safer working area for Dorset County Council whilst they carry out works to protect bridge piers on the A35, Upton bypass.

The effect of the order is as follows;

[1] To impose a temporary 30mph speed limit upon the A350 and the A35 (UPTON BY-PASS):

- a) in an eastbound direction from Bakers Arms roundabout to a point approximately 100 metres past the Upton footbridge;
- b) in a westerly direction from the Holes Bay North roundabout to a point approximately 100 metres past the slip road from the A350;
- c) the A350 elevated roundabout;
- d) all lead-ins and slip-roads to / from the A35, Upton bypass to / from the A350 elevated roundabout.
